A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON FEBRUARY 22, 2021 IN RESPONSE TO WINTER STORM URI, A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY; SET EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Mayor Kevin White, Mayor of the City of Mineola, Texas issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a local disaster for public health emergency for the City of Mineola, in response to Winter Storm Uri; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, a state of disaster for public health emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Mineola, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The declaration of the Public Health Emergency, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on Monday, February 22, 2021, shall be renewed and continued through Monday, March 22, 2021, the City's next regularly scheduled meeting date, in accordance with section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.
