## DISCUSSION ON ACTION ITEMS, PUBLIC HEARINGS, PRESENTATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

## 6. Discuss city zoning ordinance, section 6-8, D7, Off-Premise Signs.

Mr. David Madsen explained the current zoning ordinance as it applies to Off-Premise signs and the history of the ordinance.

## 7. Hold a public hearing on a zoning amendment, Section 6-8, D7, Off-Premise Sign Ordinance.

There were no citizens present for comment. Fire Marshall David Madsen gave a brief overview of the request and said that Planning and Zoning recommended denial. The request comes from a sign owner who received a violation and requested that the city start allowing off-premise signs.

## 8. Discuss and consider action on an ordinance amending Section 6-8, D.7, Off-Premise Signs.

No motion was made on the item. Failed for lack of motion. Councilmember Sue Jones asked David Madsen to look into a particular off-premise sign that was grandfathered from the ordinance. The sign is on the Mercantile building in the Historic District. Mr. Madsen said the sign is permitted through TxDot and has been allowed to

stay in its current form because it was there prior to the ordinance being passed. Mrs. Jones tasked Mr. Madsen with finding out if there is a way to have it removed and asked for future discussion on the item.

## 9. Discuss and consider action on whether or not to pursue an ordinance allowing golf carts on city streets.

Discussion was held on the item, but no motion was made. The council discussed their opposition to allowing golf carts on city streets due to the potential danger it imposes on the citizens. Failed for lack of motion.

## 10. Discuss and consider action on 2020 Meredith Requests.

Councilmember Greg Hollen made the motion to approve the request as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Polly Jones and carried by a unanimous vote.
