- 1. Discuss and consider approving the recommendation of the Selection Review Committee to award by resolution Traylor & Associates for grant administration services in conjunction with an application (if applicable) of funding from the U.S. Department of Treasury for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide project administration and project-related management services, if awarded.**

Councilmember Sue Jones made the motion to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Terry Eaton and carried by a unanimous vote.

- 2. Discuss and consider action on a proposed tax rate for FY 2021-2022.**


Councilmember Sue Jones made a motion to propose a tax rate of 0.482875. The motion failed for a lack of second. Councilmember Jack Newman made a motion to propose a tax rate of 0.482000. The motion was seconded by Mitchell Tuck and carried by a majority vote; Terry Eaton and Sue Jones opposed.

- 3. Discuss and consider action on an interlocal agreement with East Texas Council of Governments (ETCOG) for Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) from September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2023.**

Councilmember Jack Newman made the motion to approve the agreement. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Eric Carrington and carried by a unanimous vote.


ADJOURNMENT
